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► **MMA movement:** The tournament format is back. The viral videos are back. But for the second season of ambitious MMA promotion Bellator, the TV deal is quite different. Broadcast on delay in its first season on ESPN Deportes, the series is moving to live Thursday night cards on Fox Sports Net, with highlight shows to follow on NBC and Telemundo. "Two days after the tournament event happens live, you'll see a rock 'em, sock 'em half-hour (on NBC) of the greatest moments of Thursday's competition," Bellator CEO Bjorn Rebney says. Bellator had no English-language TV deal for its first season but made shows available on its site. Then with a handful of chokes and kicks from unusual angles, the company posted clips online. "I am a firm believer that when you have those magical moments, people will watch it on YouTube and then will watch it on a highlight show," Rebney says.
